

# THE BE CUP

## A SIMPLE GUIDE

- This season **The BE Cup** consists of 3 qualifying competitions:

**Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> January – Sheffield**

**Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> February – Hatfield**

**Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March – Crawley**

- The BE Cup Finals 2019 – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2019
- Players can attend 1, 2 or all 3 qualifying competitions. (if you haven't entered Hatfield or Crawley and wish to after the Sheffield qualifier please send a request to [competition@bocciaengland.org.uk](mailto:competition@bocciaengland.org.uk))
- A player needs to collect 7 points to qualify for the BE Cup Finals.  
Example:

The BE Cup Qualifier		
Name	Qualifying Points	What does it mean?
<b>1st</b>	<b>11</b>	<i>Qualifies for BE Cup finals</i>
<b>2nd</b>	<b>9</b>	<i>Qualifies for BE Cup finals</i>
<b>3rd</b>	<b>7</b>	<i>Qualifies for BE Cup finals</i>
<b>4th</b>	<b>5</b>	<i>Needs to gain 2 more points to qualify</i>
<b>5th</b>	<b>3</b>	<i>Needs to gain 4 more points to qualify</i>
<b>6th</b>	<b>2</b>	<i>Needs to gain 5 more points to qualify</i>
<b>7th</b>	<b>1</b>	<i>Needs to gain 6 more points to qualify</i>

- If you have 7 points following the first and second qualifier you can still compete in the third qualifier. You will be removed from receiving anymore qualification point sand your points will be passed down directly to the next player. You will however still receive ranking points. (4.2 The BE Cup Rules and Guidelines)
- Automatic Qualifiers have also been invited to enter The BE Cup qualifiers. 'If an Automatic Qualifier competes at a BE Cup Qualifier, they will be removed from receiving any qualification points, these points will be passed down directly to the next player. They will however still receive ranking points.' (4.1 The BE Cup Rules and Guidelines)

- The qualification system uses the same points totals as the ranking system. (The full points graph can be found in *appendix 2* of the BE Cup Rules and Guidelines)
- An example of how players collect points over the 3 qualifying competitions can be found in *appendix 3* of the BE Cup Rules and Guidelines.
- When a BE Cup Qualifier competition includes BC4s and BC5s, BC4s will be awarded 'make up' points based on their final position in the competition in their class.

1 <sup>st</sup> place BC4	3 'make up' points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place BC4	2 'make up' points
3 <sup>rd</sup> place BC4	1 'make up' point
